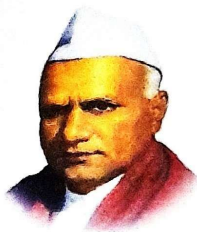


Study Tour at Amba - B.Sc. III Botany Students

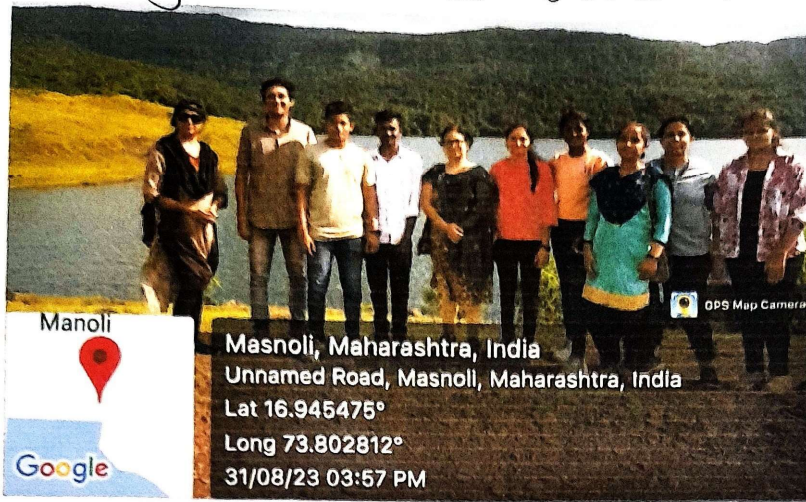
7. Brief description:

On Thursday, August 31, 2023, the Department of Botany at Vivekanand College, Kolhapur (Empowered Autonomous) organised a study tour to Amba and the surrounding area as well as Shailesh Nursery. The primary goal of the study tour was to gather and carefully examine cryptogams and phanerogams in their native environments. Students stopped at Shailesh Nursery in Malkapur en route to view and learn about various indoor, outdoor, and ornamental fruit plants. It instills and encourages a variety of employment opportunities in students minds. This study excursion was attended by 22 B.Sc. III (Botany) and B.Sc. II (Plant Protection) students. Drs. 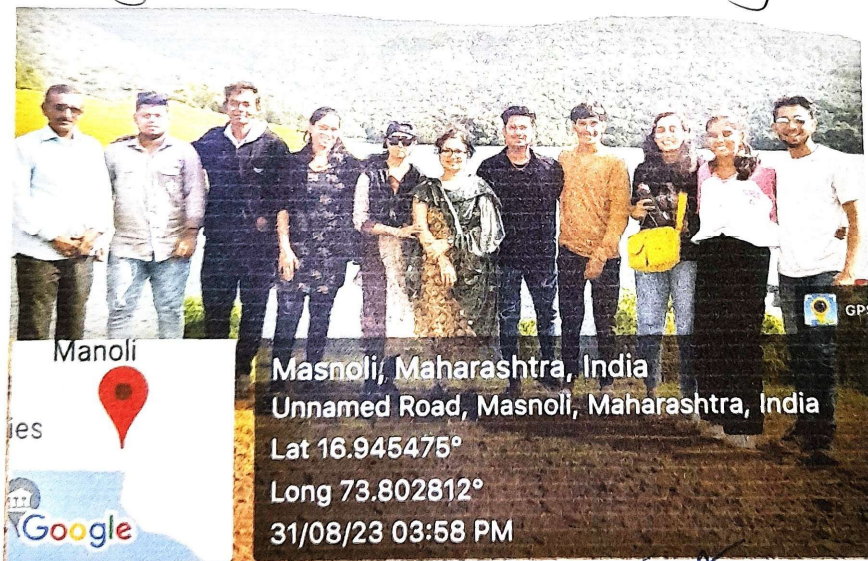
