

III and II (Major) students to visit Kode Dam and Gaganbawda, accompanied by Dr. A.R. Kasarkar. Located in the western ghats, Gaganbawda was renowned for its breathtaking scenery. There were two ghats that originated in Gaganbawda and went in different directions. The two ghats, Karul and Bhuibawada, are incredibly rich in biodiversity. Studying the vegetation type, flora and fauna, topography, soil type, climate, and plant habits and habitat are the primary goals of botanical excursions. Students are acquainted with the endemic plants found in the

Western Ghats. Twelve students enrolled in this study tour program. All in all, the visit greatly enhanced the students' educational experience by bridging the gap between theory and real-world application.
