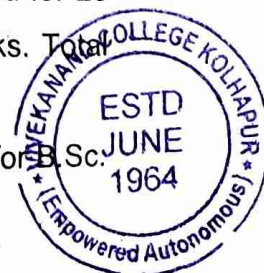

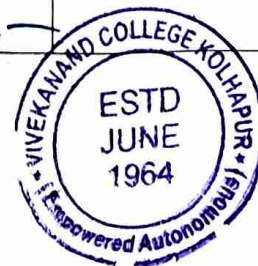

Members Present

The 16th meeting of the Board of Studies (BoS) in Chemistry was conducted under the chairmanship of the Prof. Dr. S. D. Shirke. The members of the Board of Studies were present for the meeting.

Agenda and Proceedings

Agenda Item 1: Confirmation of the Minutes of the Previous Meeting

The minutes of the previous meeting of the Board of Studies in Chemistry were placed before the members. The members reviewed the minutes and confirmed them without any objection.

Resolution:

The minutes of the previous BoS meeting were unanimously confirmed.

Agenda Item 2: Incorporation of Stakeholder Feedback in the Curriculum

The feedback received from various stakeholders, including students, teachers, alumni, employers and other relevant stakeholders, was discussed in detail. The members examined the suggestions and recommended incorporating relevant and feasible suggestions into the curriculum to enhance its academic relevance and responsiveness to current requirements.

Resolution:

The Board approved the incorporation of appropriate stakeholder feedback in the curriculum and syllabus wherever feasible.

Agenda Item 3: Discussion on CO-PO Attainment of the Previous Syllabus

The Course Outcome (CO) and Programme Outcome (PO) attainment of the previous syllabus was presented and discussed. The members reviewed the attainment levels and suggested suitable measures for improving the attainment of learning outcomes.



The structure and syllabus for the fourth year of the B.Sc. programme under the Honours and Honours with Research categories were discussed in accordance with the applicable NEP framework and institutional guidelines. The members discussed advanced subject content, research orientation, project work and skill development components.

Resolution:

The Board approved the proposed syllabus and structure for B.Sc. Fourth Year Honours and Honours with Research for implementation from the academic year 2026-27.

Agenda Item 8: Assessment of One-Credit Courses

The proposal regarding the assessment of one-credit courses was discussed. It was proposed that each one-credit theory or practical course should be assessed for **25 marks**. Accordingly, each semester comprising 22 credits would carry **550 marks**, and the total marks for the three-year UG programme would be **3300 marks**.

Resolution:

The Board approved the proposed assessment structure of 25 marks for each one-credit course and the corresponding semester-wise and programme-wise marks distribution.

Agenda Item 9: 60:40 Evaluation Pattern

The proposed **60:40 evaluation pattern**, comprising End Semester Examination and Internal Evaluation respectively, for B.Sc. I and M.Sc. I courses from the academic year 2026-27 was discussed.

Resolution:

The Board approved the 60:40 evaluation pattern, i.e. **60% End Semester Examination and 40% Internal Evaluation**, for B.Sc. I and M.Sc. I courses from the academic year 2026-27.

Agenda Item 10: Time Allocation for Question Papers

The proposed time allocation for examinations was discussed. The following duration was finalized:

- **30 Marks Question Paper:** 1 hour 30 minutes
- **60 Marks Question Paper:** 2 hours 30 minutes

Resolution:

The Board approved the proposed examination duration for 30-mark and 60-mark question papers.



Agenda Item 11: Continuous Internal Evaluation (CIE) Pattern

The members discussed the Continuous Internal Evaluation (CIE) pattern to be followed for the revised curriculum from the academic year 2026-27. Various components of internal assessment, including appropriate academic activities and evaluation methods, were discussed to ensure continuous assessment of students' knowledge, skills and learning outcomes.

Resolution:

The Board approved the proposed CIE framework for implementation from the academic year 2026-27, with suitable components aligned with the course outcomes and programme requirements.

Agenda Item 12: Minor Changes in M.Sc. I and M.Sc. II Syllabus

Minor modifications in the syllabi of **M.Sc. I and M.Sc. II – Analytical Chemistry and Organic Chemistry** were presented before the members. The proposed changes were discussed with respect to content relevance, sequencing, current developments in the subject and academic requirements.

After discussion, the suggested minor modifications were approved.

Resolution:

The Board approved the proposed minor changes in the M.Sc. I and M.Sc. II syllabi of Analytical Chemistry and Organic Chemistry.

Agenda Item 13: Any Other Matter with the Permission of the Chairperson

No other matter requiring detailed discussion was raised. The Chairperson thanked all the members for their valuable suggestions and active participation in the meeting.
