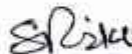

Event-Wise Guidelines

▪ **Poster & Model Presentation: *Demonstrating Through Design***

1. Theme: "**Chemistry for Sustainable, Smart and Healthy Future**"
(**Suggested Thematic Areas:** Climate Change & Chemistry, Sustainable energy, Medicinal chemistry, material chemistry, AI-driven drug design, smart polymers, graphene, advanced materials, etc.)
2. Poster size: Maximum 1 meter X 1 meter.
3. Printed or neatly handwritten posters are allowed.
4. Poster must include title, student name(s), class, and department.
5. Content should be original, clear, and theme-based.
6. Use of diagrams and illustrations is encouraged.
7. Participant must be present during evaluation.
8. Maximum only 2 participants in one group is allowed.



▪ **Elocution Competition:** *Where Words React Like Molecules*

1. Topics for the elocution are as follows:
 - Chemistry-The Silent Hero of Modern life
 - AI in chemistry
 - Next generation energy sources
 - Climate change and science behind it
2. Time limit: **5 min + 1 min.**

▪ **Chem-Magic:** *When Chemistry Feels Like Magic*

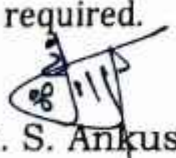
1. Experiments must be safe and non-hazardous.

▪ **Chem-Quiz:** *A Battle of Brains and Bonds*

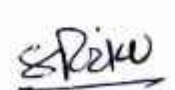
1. Quiz will be conducted in rounds.
