→ Deming has been universally acclaimed as one of the founding fathers of Total Quality Management, if not the founding father. The revolution in Japanese manufacturing management that led to the economic miracle of the 1970s and 1980s has been attributed largely to Deming.

\* Total Quality Management can be divided into four categories :-

- 1) Planning
- 2) Do
- 3) Check
- 4) Act.

\* Deming's 14 Obligation of Top Management.

- 1) Create Consistency of Purpose
- 2) Adopt a New Philosophy.
- 3) Create dependence on Inspection.
- 4) Stop Awarding Business based on \$\$ Alone.
- 5) Continuous Improvement on Production Processes
- 6) Modernize on Job Training.
- 7) Institute Leadership.
- 8) Drive out fear.
