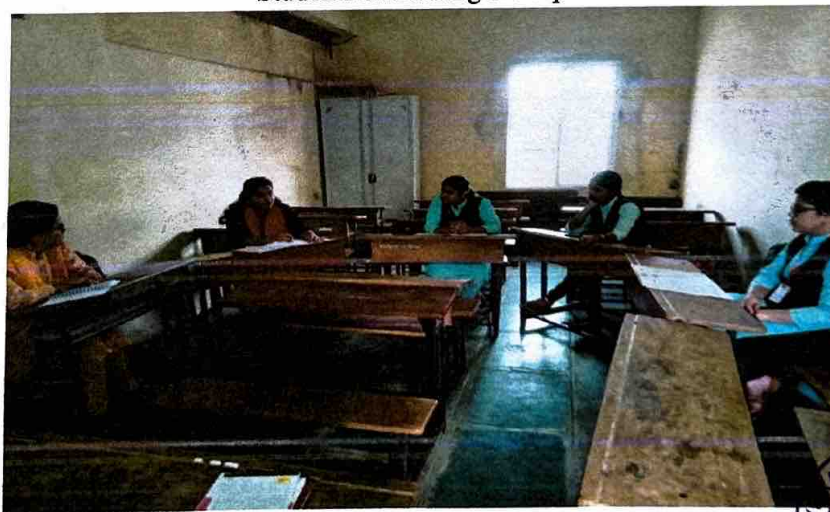


- 8. Outcome:** 1) The participating students read and presented on the topic of human rights and their violation.

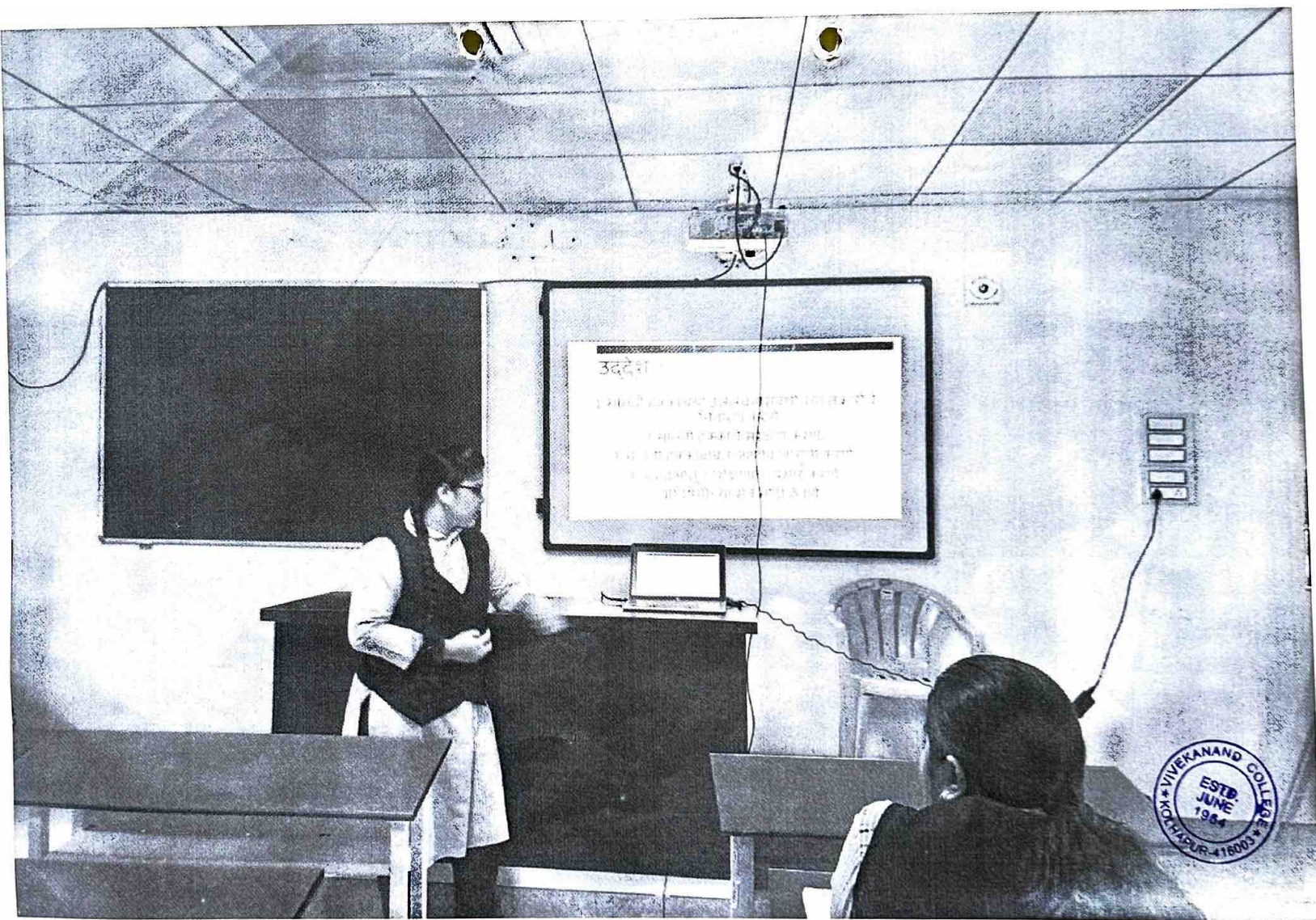

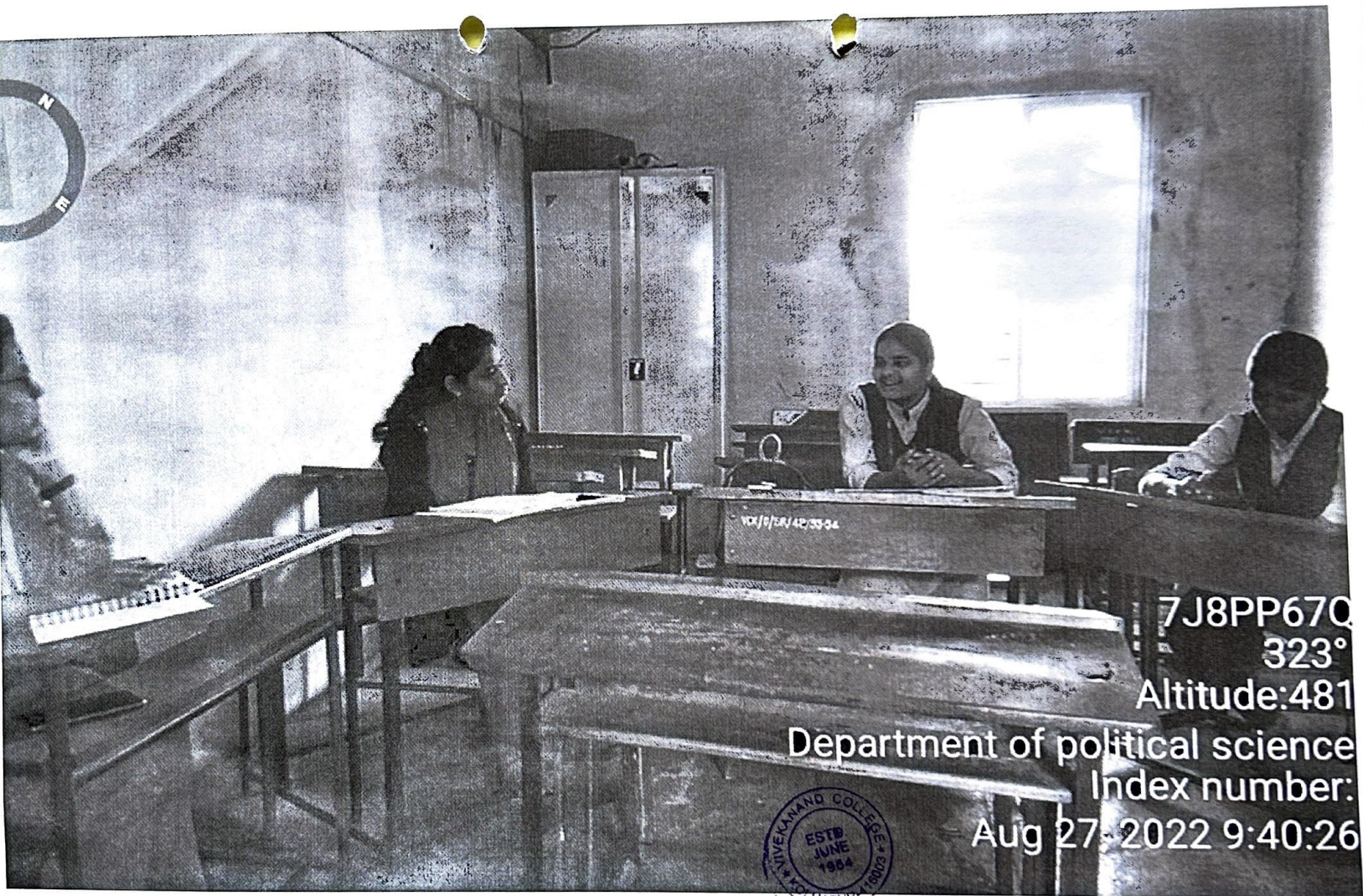
