### Report on Field Visit: Fish Market Kolhapur (18th March 2025)

The Department of Zoology, Vivekanand College, Kolhapur, organized a field visit for B.Sc. Part-II Zoology students as part of their curriculum on Tuesday, 18<sup>th</sup> March 2025, to the Kolhapur Fish Market.
