**Time Limits:** Each response will have a time limit.


**Round 3: Final Round**






## QUIZ COMPETITION

### Report

Wildlife Week is celebrated annually in India from October 2 to October 8 to raise awareness about the importance of wildlife and conservation. This year, the Department of Zoology at Vivekanand College organized an awareness quiz on October 5, 2024, as part of the celebrations.

The event commenced with an initial round consisting of 30 theory questions, engaging students in an interactive format. From this round, six participants were selected for the second round. In the second round, each participant was asked questions one by one, allowing for a focused evaluation of their knowledge.

Each of these participants received a certificate for their achievements, while the first-place winner was awarded a trophy in addition to their certificate.
