Action Taken on feedback on Curriculum 2023-24

Feedback was obtained on curriculum from four key stakeholders, i.e. students, teachers, alumni and employers in the 2023-24. The feedback was collected online in google forms and in person in hard copies. The feedback analysis report and the main suggestions of the stakeholders were presented before the Academic Council. BoS chairpersons are members of the Academic Council.

Subject specific suggestions were forwarded to the respective departments for further discussion and decisions. After discussion at departmental level, the respective Heads put forth important recommendations in their BoS. Important suggestions regarding syllabus are discussed in the BoS and are sought to be incorporated in the syllabus designing in the subsequent year.

The following is the summary of actions taken on stakeholders' recommendations on the curriculum implemented at the college.

Student Feedback		
1	Incorporate real-world examples, case studies, and applications into the curriculum to make it more relevant and engaging for students.	The VSC, SEC, OE, CEP courses in the NEP syllabi of all the subjects have been designed to include real life examples, case studies, field visits and subject specific skills.
2	Include examples to clear concepts.	The college conducts teacher assessment by students separately to understand students'

		feedback on teaching. This assessment is designed to understand how student centric the teaching is.
3	Including AI in curriculum.	Knowledge of AI has been incorporated in Computer Science courses.
4	Add some real time industry level skills.	Industry exposure has been enhanced through the number of industry visits, MoUs and linkages, especially under NEP.
5	More time be allotted to practicals.	The college has increased laboratory infrastructure and computer labs to enable practical learning.
6	Notes on the syllabus should be provided in a systematic manner.	The Principal has given instructions to departments to ensure students get notes properly on NEP and autonomous syllabus. Teachers are encouraged to suggest reference books and text books for purchase in the library.
7	The curriculum should be more based on the future aspects of career rather than just being academic oriented	Due note has been taken of this feedback and the instructions have been given to departments to include better career-oriented content in the syllabus.
8	Deliver the lectures using high quality tools.	The college has allocated funds for technological upgradation for teaching-learning purposes, such upgradation and skill upgradation of teachers is also encouraged.
Alumni Feedback		
1	Curriculum should be more addressed to industry and trends.	The syllabi are regularly updated to address industry trends. Greater industry oriented content has been incorporated in the syllabus.

2	Training of English communication should be given.	Department of English has introduced a course in association with BOSH for professional English communication training.
3	Need for advanced technology.	Departments are encouraged to identify and incorporate newer technology in pedagogy. Teachers are given financial assistance for skill upgradation to use newer technology.

Teacher Feedback

1	Practical syllabus needs to be improved so that students take interest in respective subjects.	Departments have been directed to include newer and more practical components in respective syllabi to make those more application oriented. This is done through the new NEP courses.
2	Input from Industry experts and alumni should be given more weightage while designing the curriculum.	Due note is taken of this point. Feedback from industry and alumni are diligently considered by the departments.
3	CIE should be more Holistic and inclusive	Departments are given freedom to design their own methods of CIE.
4	Internship and On Job Training should be implemented properly.	OJTs and internships have been made part of the curriculum at UG and PG levels.
