Action Taken Report on Feedback on Curriculum- 2019-20

The feedback on the curriculum implemented in the academic year 2019-20 was obtained from four stakeholders, i.e. students, teachers, alumni and employers. The formal feedback was taken through online mode and the informal was registered by the stakeholders in class, department meetings, campus placement drives etc. The combined analysis report of the formal feedback was presented in the Academic Council of which BoS chairpersons are members. The particular points in the subject specific feedback given by the stakeholders are considered at departmental level and the respective BoS. The recommendations that are found to be important and feasible are incorporated in the subsequent syllabus designing.
