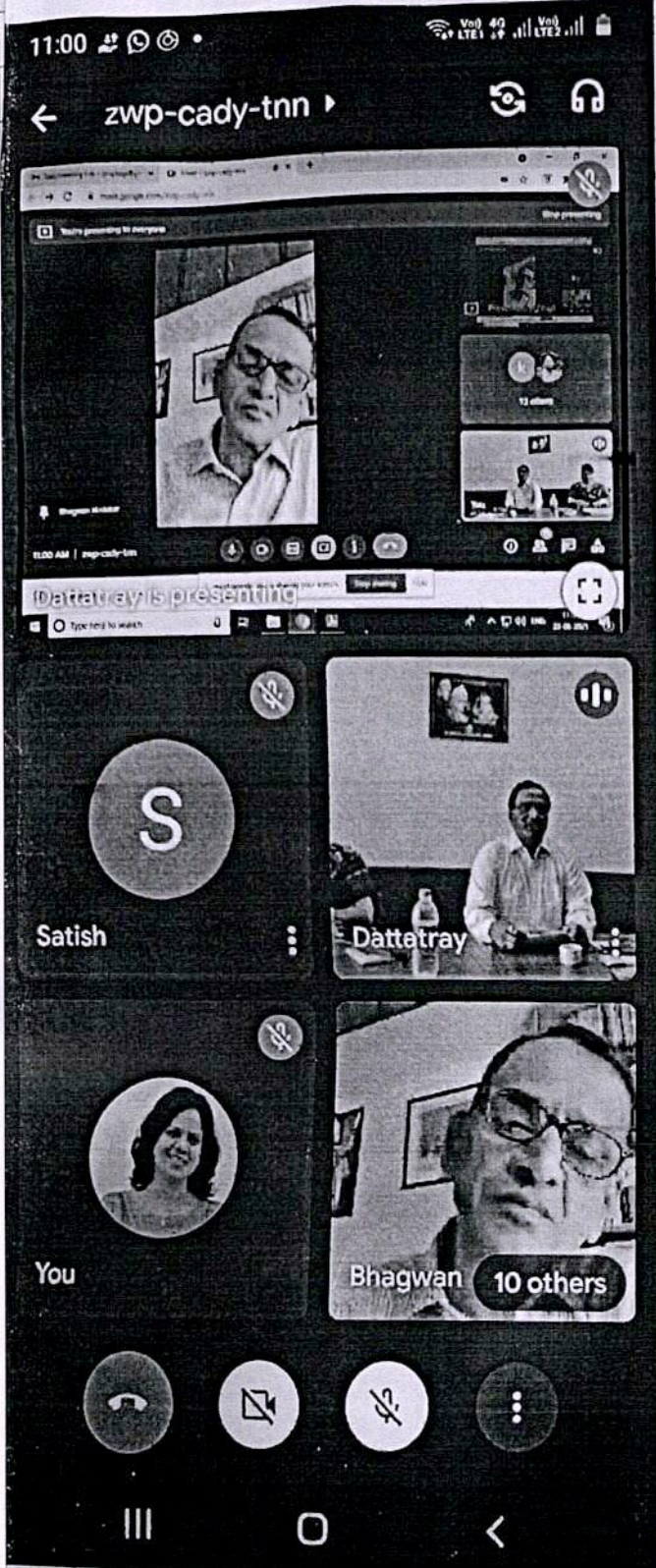

4. Any other matter with the permission of the chair.

i. Principal Dr. R.R. Kumbhar reported that the college has been given the responsibility of selection of foreign students to BBA and other courses of the university from amongst the applications received by the University. Dr. Prabha Patil of our college is coordinating the selection process. She presented her view that the college should consider starting **BBA degree course in Tourism and Hospitality Management** considering the demand of students for these streams.

Dr. B. M. Hirdekar said that the college should consider launching vertical BBA program with degree in E-commerce, tourism, banking, mall management etc under new MSME related academic programs where students receive stipend during the degree years and are readily absorbed in industry after graduation.

ii. Dr. B. M. Hirdekar proposed that the performance of the faculty during the pandemic be mapped through data sheet which includes indicators like research output, and educational e-content development.

iii. Dr. B. M. Hirdekar suggested that the college take lead in organising a meeting of all autonomous colleges to discuss the difficulties faced and strategies employed by the colleges during pandemic.

iv. Dr. B. M. Hirdekar suggested that all departments in the college conduct a meeting with the departing students of their respective departments to understand and note their career choices and future plans and guide them accordingly.

v. Mr. Sunil Malgaonkar, chairman of CO-PO mapping committee, reported the progress in developing the system of CO-PO mapping. Dr. B.M. Hirdekar suggested checking AICTE document on the same and also explore the idea of program focused attainment introduced by some universities abroad to incorporate certain points therein into our system.

vi. Dr. S. R. Kattimani presented a power point presentation containing the important qualitative matrices in NAAC SSR and underlined the importance of focusing on preparing and writing well



worded answers to each of this matrix in preparation to the next NAAC accreditation. He specified certain areas to be focused.

v. Dr. Kavita Tiwade requested Mr. Ranbhare, chairperson of the alumni association, to conduct certain programs for college under the initiative of the association. Mr. Ranbhare presented the idea of a lecture series that will be organised by the association and the programs of financial assistance to 25 students. Both were unanimously agreed to.

vi. Dr. B. M. Hirdekar proposed that students performing poorly in first and second year of graduation be identified as slow learners and be coached by the retired or existing faculty members to improve their performance in the third year. He suggested that it be implemented as a structured programme.

vi. Dr. Kavita Tiwade reported that the department of English will be convening an international seminar in the coming academic year.

vii. Dr. S. R. Kattimani proposed that the scope of 'student satisfaction survey' (SSS) to be carried out at towards the end of the academic year be enhanced by including all round questions on students' experience in the college, like that of admission process, non-teaching services, mentoring etc. Dr. Hirdekar suggested to refer to student happiness index implemented by IITs while undertaking this expansion of SSS.

viii. Dr. Kavita Tiwade suggested that all social outreach activities be brought under one banner by the college and the college engage with Zilla Parishad and Gram Panchayats by adopting more communities to support them in difficult times like pandemic.

ix. It was decided to organise a two-day workshop cum excursion for non-teaching staff with Bahai Academy, Pachagani, or Yashada, Pune, or Sanjay Ghodawat University, Kolhapur. It was noted that improving the happiness of non-teaching staff was essential for smooth administration and student satisfaction.

x. Dr. Shubhangi Kale suggested that teacher-training on consultancy should be organised for Arts and Commerce teachers in the college to enhance their contributions in consultancy services offered by the college.

xi. Prin Dr. R. R. Kumbhar reported that all examinations were conducted smoothly in the college during pandemic. Dr. B. M. Hirdekar congratulated the faculty for this achievement.

xii. B.Voc faculty member Mr. Satish Upalawikar asked Dr. Hirdekar for guidance on introducing innovative practices to B.Voc. programmes. Dr. Hirdekar spoke about new trends like



'21st century design'; he promised to provide guidance regarding resource persons in the event of workshops on such new trends.

Prin. Dr. R. R. Kumbhar reported about the new B.Voc. Programme proposals in beauty parlour, hotel management, agriculture that have been sanctioned in Academic Council meeting. Dr. Hirdekar suggested to consider Bachelor of Management Studies program in areas like air transport to introduce in the future .

xiii. Dr. B. M. Hirdekar advised that a Reservoir of free e-books should be created with the help of faculty members and the same be made available to students and faculty upon demand.

xiv. Dr. S. R. Kattimani raised the point about Academic and Administrative Audit of the college. Dr. B. M. Hirdekar said that the AAA can be carried out by following the distancing norms.

xv. IQAC coordinator Dr. Shruti Joshi sought advice of the committee members on online organisation of Vivekanand Mahotsav. Dr. Hirdekar advised that the college should organise the mega event in future by collaborating with other institutes/organisations like other colleges of our Shikshan Sansthas to expand the scope and include innovative events like shoe designing, hair dressing, dress designing as part of competitions.
