Memorandum of Understanding (MoU)

In accordance with a mutual desire to promote activities between College of Chemistry and Chemical Engineering, Henan University, China and Department of Physics, Vivekanand College, Kolhapur (Autonomous), Maharashtra, India, the two institutions

(organizations) agree to the following statement of intent on cultural, educational and research cooperation.

Cooperation and development of activities may extend to any fields and subjects in which the two institutions (organizations) may identify shared interests. The initial area of cooperation is academic and research collaborations.

The two institutions (organizations) agree to cooperate in the following general areas;

- 01) An exchange of scholars and scientists to conduct research of mutual interest.
- 02) An exchange of faculty for lectures and short term visits.
- 03) Invitations to scientists to participate in conferences and symposia.
- 04) An exchange of information, academic materials and publications in fields of mutual interest.

Both parties agree that all financial arrangements necessary to implement this General Agreement or any subsequent agreements must be negotiated according to the regulations of each institution and will be dependent upon the availability of funds. Both parties recognize that this General Agreement establishes a foundation of mutual understanding and interest, and does not in itself entail any financial obligations to either organization.

Each institute (organization) will appoint a liaison officer who will be responsible for the coordination and the administration of collaboration/exchange programs. Each liaison officer will be responsible for providing his/her counterpart with information about the academic background, record and interests of proposed participants in the exchange. It is understood that both institutions will nominate only individuals of the highest scholastic standing and potential.

This agreement for partnership, cooperation and scientific exchange shall remain in effect for a period of five (05) years from the date of the last signature, with the understanding that it may be terminated by either party given three (03) months written notice to the partner institute.

This agreement may be amended with the consent of both institutions through a written addendum executed by authorized individuals from both institutions.



- 2. राजभाषा हिंदी की पढ़ाई का प्रचार करना।
- 3. भारत में प्रचलित सभी भाषाओं, विशेष रुप में मराठी भाषा के व्दारा हिंदी के विकास में सहायता प्रदान करने का) प्रयास करना तथा भारत में प्रचलित सभी भाषाओं का हिंदी के साथ पारस्परिक संबंध के लिए मराठी आदि भाषाओं की पढ़ाई का प्रावधान करना। उनके माध्यम से सभी पोषक प्रवृत्तियों को चलाना तथा राष्ट्रीय एकात्मता को पुष्ट करना ।



A) First Party is a Higher Educational Institution named:

- C) First Party & Second Party believe that collaboration and co-operation between themselves will promote more effective use of each of their resources, and provide each of them with enhanced opportunities.
- D) The Parties intent to co-operate and focus their efforts on cooperation within area of Skill Based Training and Education.
- E) Both Parties, being legal entities in themselves desire to sign this MoU for advancing their mutual interests.

NOW THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE MUTUAL PROMISES SET FORTH IN THIS MOU, THE PARTIES HERE TO AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

Clause 1 CO-OPERATION

- 1.1 Both Parties are united by common interests and objectives, and they shall establish channels of communication and co-operation that will promote and advance their respective operations within the Institution and its related wings. The Parties shall keep each other informed of potential opportunities and shall share all information that may be relevant to secure additional opportunities for one another.
- 1.2 First Party and Second Party co-operation will facilitate effective utilization of the intellectual capabilities of the faculty of First and Second Party to providing or exchange significant inputs to each other for developing suitable teaching / skill training systems, keeping in mind the needs of the pure academic purpose.
- 1.3 Strengthening institutions to produce high quality students for better employability.
- 1.4 Scaling-up UG Education and Demand-Driven Research & Development and Innovation.
- 1.5 Establishing Centers of Excellence for focused applicable research Training of faculty for effective Teaching.
- 1.6 Enhancing institutional effectiveness.
- 1.7 The general terms of co-operation shall be governed by this MoU. The Parties shall cooperate with each other and shall, as promptly as is reasonably practical, enter into all relevant agreements, deeds and documents (the 'Definitive Documents') as may be required to give effect to the actions contemplated in terms of this MoU. The term of Definitive Documents shall be mutually decided between the Parties. Along with the Definitive Documents, this MoU shall represent the entire understanding as to the

subject matter hereof and shall supersede any prior understanding between the Parties on the subject matter hereof.

Clause 2 SCOPE OF THE MoU

- 2.1 The budding graduates from the institutions could play a key role in technological upgradation, innovation and competitiveness in different sectors of society. Both parties believe that close co-operation between the two would be of major benefit to the student community to enhance their skills and knowledge.
- 2.2 Curriculum Design: Both first and Second Party will give valuable inputs to teaching / training methodology and suitably customize the curriculum so that the students fit into the different sectors meaningfully.
- 2.3 **Research and Development:** Both First and Second Parties have agreed to carry out the joint research activities in the fields of Geography.
- 2.4 Skill Development Programs: Both First and Second Party to train the students on the GIS, GPS, Remote Sensing, Cartography, Surveying, Soil and Water Assessment, Travel and Tourism techniques in order to bridge the skill gap and make them ready for the future employment.
- 2.5 Guest Lectures: Both First and Second Party to extend the necessary support to deliver guest lectures to the students of the First and Second Party.
- 2.6 Exchange of Students: Both First and Second Party to extend the necessary support to exchange of the students for academic programmes.
- 2.7 Both Parties to obtain all internal approvals, consents, permissions, and licenses of whatsoever nature required for offering the Programmes on the terms specified herein.
- 2.8 There is no financial commitment in both First and Second Party on the part of to take up any programme mentioned in the MoU. If there is any financial consideration, it will be dealt separately.

Clause 3 INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

3.1 Nothing contained in this MoU shall, by express grant, implication, Estoppel or otherwise, create in either Party any right, title, interest, or license in or to the intellectual property (including but not limited to know-how, inventions, patents, copy rights and designs) of the other Party.

Clause 4 VALIDITY

- 4.1 This Agreement will be valid until it is expressly terminated by either Party on mutually agreed terms, during which period, the Second Party, as the case may be, will take effective steps for implementation of this MoU.
- 4.2 Both Parties may terminate this MoU upon 30 calendar days' notice in writing. In the event of Termination, both parties have to discharge their obligations.

Clause 5 RELATIONSHIPS BETWEEN THE PARTIES

5.1 It is expressly agreed that First Party and Second Party are acting under this MoU as independent contractors, and the relationship established under this MoU shall not be construed as a partnership. Neither Party is authorized to use the other Party's name in any way, to make any representations or create any obligation or liability, expressed or implied, on behalf of the other Party, without the prior written consent of the other Party. Neither Party shall have, nor represent itself as having, any authority under the terms of this MoU to make agreements of any kind in the name of or binding upon the other Party, to pledge the other Party's credit, or to extend credit on behalf of the other Party.

Any divergence or difference derived from the interpretation or application of the MoU shall be resolved by arbitration between the parties as per the Arbitration Act, 1996. The place of the arbitration shall be at District Head Quarters of the First and Second Party. This undertaking is to be construed in accordance with Indian Law with exclusive jurisdiction in the Courts of Kolhapur.

Memorandum of Collaboration for **Faculty Development**

Between

Shri Swami Vivekanand Shikshan Sanstha (SSVSS), Kolhapur

And

Indian Institute of Science Education and Research (IISER), Pune, through the Maharashtra State Development of Educators and Enhancement in Delivery (MS-DEED) Program supported by the Maharashtra State Faculty Development Academy (MSFDA)

In accordance with a mutual desire to promote faculty development activities in education field between the Indian Institute of Science Education and Research (IISER), Pune's Maharashtra State Development of Educators and Enhancement in Delivery (MS-DEED) Program funded by the Maharashtra State Faculty Development Academy (MSFDA) and Shri Swami Vivekanand Shikshan Sanstha (SSVSS), Kolhapur, the two institutions agree to the following statement of intent on faculty members training.

The Indian Institute of Science Education and Research (IISER) Pune is a premier institute dedicated to research and teaching in the basic sciences; whereas Shri Swami Vivekanand Shikshan Sanstha (SSVSS), Kolhapur is an educational institute devoted to the dissemination of education for knowledge, science and culture among the masses. Both the institutions believe that a favourable environment for modern, effective and community-oriented development in the academic fraternity is the need of the hour through pedagogical training to teachers as well as hands-on science education to students and teachers at various levels. This collaboration aims at:

- 1. Improving the quality and engagement of faculty in the preparedness for NEP 2020
- Excelling the teaching fraternity for effective and outcome-oriented classroom and lab engagement
- 3. Helping the teachers with skills in areas of scientific inquiry and problem-solving
- 4. Motivating the teachers to imbibe critical thinking abilities among their students
- 5. Improving individual output for sustainable development of the community

To achieve these objectives, the two institutions agree to cooperate in the following manner:

Level 1:

- MS-DEED team of IISER, Pune, will conduct training sessions for all science and mathematics faculty members of higher education institutes of SSVSS, Kolhapur.
- These sessions will be organized at Kolhapur, Miraj, Satara, Beed, Osmanabad and Pune divisional centres of SSVSS, Kolhapur.
- These faculty development/training sessions will be one and a half to two days, with synchronous and asynchronous engagement.
- SSVSS will identify and nominate between 100-150 teachers of higher education institutes
 from the above-mentioned divisional centres and other institutes and colleges from the region
 for each workshop.
- MS-DEED team of trainers will conduct these sessions and carry out the assessment. The expenses for content development, resource person travel and honourarium will be borne by MS-DEED programme.

- The expenses for these training sessions, including venue, participant travel, lodging and boarding, will be borne by SSVSS, Kolhapur.
- SSVSS will appoint a person of contact for effective communication with the MS-DEED coordinator.

Level 2:

- From the Level 1 training, the MS-DEED team, with support from SSVSS, will select motivated participant teachers for the advanced training at IISER, Pune.
- This training will be scheduled for ten days. The expenses, including venue, resource person travel, lodging and boarding of participants, will be incorporated, as appropriate, within the ongoing MS-DEED programmes of IISER, Pune.

Since the understanding is on a principal-to-principal basis, both parties agree that all logistic and financial arrangements necessary to implement this collaboration or any subsequent linkages must be made by each institution. Both parties recognize that this collaboration establishes a foundation of mutual understanding and interest and does not in itself entail any financial obligations to either organization.

This collaboration shall be effective from the date it is signed by the parties hereto. The duration of the collaboration will be initially for a period of three years from the effective date, unless or otherwise terminated earlier.

This agreement may be amended with the consent of both institutions through a written addendum executed by authorized individuals from both institutions.

2. Financial Arrangements

Each party shall bear its own expenses incurred in the course of its performance under this Agreement.

3. Intellectual property (IP)

Credit of outcome of the collaboration should accrue credit to both the institutions.

4. Confidentiality

The parties understand that in the course of their association, they shall have access to confidential information provided by the other party. Accordingly, the parties agree that such information shall be maintained in the strictest confidence and trust, expect such information which is by its nature, not confidential or which is in the public domain or which the party comes to know about other than through violation of any law of legal obligation, provided that such party may be entitled to disclose such information if legally required to be disclosed to a competent authority. Failure to maintain confidentiality shall entitle the affected party to terminate the MoU.

- (i) During and for a period of 5 year from the date of termination of this MOU, each party undertakes on their behalf and on the behalf of their subcontractors/employees /representatives/ associates to maintain strict confidentiality and prevent disclosure of the information/data exchanged / generated pursuant to this MOU for any purpose other than in accordance with this MOU.
- (ii) Upon termination or dissolution of this MOU, or upon earlier determination there of, each party shall return to the other party all disclosing party's known tangible forms of the confidential information and copies thereof in the receiving party's possession and shall delete or erase all tangible/intangible confidential information of the disclosing party in its possession. If requested by the disclosing party an officer of the receiving party shall certify in writing

5. Term of MoU and termination

- a. - d. In case either party wins a consultancy project by projecting this MOU, a liability is created immediately in respect of royalty/premium/over head expenses due to either party. Either party shall concur with the liability to the extent of contribution to the output of the project. Both the parties will arrive at the exact amount of liability after mutual consent.
- e. Both the Institutes agree to invite teaching faculty and students to participate in mutual exchange on occasion of organizing seminar, conference, workshop etc.

This MoU unless extended by a mutual written agreement of both the parties shall expire 5 years after the effective date specified in the opening paragraph. This MoU may be amended or terminated earlier by mutual written consent by both the parties at any time. Either party shall have the right to unilaterally terminate this MoU upon 30 days prior written notice to the other party. Failure of either party to terminate the MoU on account of breach or default by the other party shall not constitute a waiver of that party's right to terminate this MoU.

Upon Termination or Expiration of this MoU, any equipment, data, literature, books, journals, dissertations, thesis etc., shall be returned to the respective institutions, within 15 working days.

6. Representations, Warranties and Liability

GSS College and Vivekanad College will hold each other unconditionally harmless from any possible claims or damages brought by THIRD PARTIES against each other in connection with the performance of this Agreement.

Either of the Institutes shall not be held responsible or liable for any damage to the property, material or personnel of the either Institute or any monitory losses to the any of the Institute, in consequence of the jobs taken up by either

Neither party has any right or authority to accept any service, or receive any notices on behalf of the other party or to enter into any commitments, undertakings, or agreements purporting to obligate such other party in any way, or to amend, modify or vary any existing agreements to which such other party may be a party.

9. Assignment

The rights and/or liabilities arising to any party to this MoU shall not be assigned except with the written consent of the other party and subject to such terms and conditions as may be mutually agreed upon.

10. Force Majeure

Vivekanand College, Kolhapur (Autonomous), having its headquarters at 2130 E Ward, Tarabai Park, Kolhapur 416003 (hereinafter referred to as "the Institute", which expression shall unless repugnant to the context shall mean and include its administrators, executors and permitted assigns).

WHEREAS:

- QHF is a non-profit organization engaged in executing Corporate Social Responsibility ("CSR")
 initiatives of Quick Heal Technologies Limited ("QHTL") including but not limited to
 promotion of cyber security, promotion of education QHTL is a company incorporated under
 the provisions of Companies Act, 1956 and a leading provider of internet security solutions
 having its registered office in Pune, Maharashtra.
- 2. The Institute is affiliated to Shivaji University Kolhapur;
- 3. QHF desires to collaborate with such third parties to fulfill and implement the CSR initiatives.
- The Institute has represented to QHF that it desires to participate in and support the CSR initiatives carried out by QHF.
- Based on the representations made by the Institute, QHF desires to collaborate with the Institute on a non-exclusive basis in order to promote its objectives in accordance with the terms and conditions of this MOU.
- The Parties wish to enter into this MOU in order to record their intent and understanding for the collaboration.

QHF and the Institute shall individually be referred to as a "Party" and collectively as the "Parties".

 - 1.1 Applicable Laws shall mean any and all national, central, state, municipal and / or local legislations, rules, regulations, statutes, ordinances, bye-laws, directions, orders and decrees of any government, statutory or other authority and any other instrument or pronouncement having the force of law as may be issued and as may be in force from time to time.
 - 1.2 Confidential Information shall mean such proprietary information or data of either Party which is not available in the public domain and is considered to be confidential by its very nature.

- 1.3 Intellectual Property Rights shall mean all worldwide intellectual property rights, including without limitation, copyrights, trademarks, service marks, know-how and all other proprietary rights, whether registered or unregistered.
- 1.4 MOU shall mean this MOU, together with its Annexures, as may be supplemented, amended, restated or replaced from time to time in accordance with this MOU.
- 1.5 Term shall have the meaning ascribed to it in clause 3.
- 2) Scope: The Parties have entered into this MOU on a non-exclusive basis in order to carry out such responsibilities, as more particularly detailed in Annexure A of this MOU. Unless otherwise indicated in Annexure A of this MOU or expressly agreed in writing between the Parties, QHF and the Institute will fulfill its respective obligations herein, respectively at their sole expense and without any cost to the other Party.
- 3) Term and Termination: This MOU will be valid and binding on the Parties for a period of one year commencing from the Effective Date unless otherwise terminated in accordance with this MOU. Either Party may terminate this MOU for convenience by providing a written notice of thirty (30) days to the other Party. Without prejudice to any other rights and remedies available to it hereunder or at law, QHF may at its sole discretion terminate this MOU immediately upon providing written notice to the Institute if the Institute is in breach of its obligations hereunder and such breach is not cured within seven (07) days from notice of receipt by QHF informing about such breach. Upon termination or expiry of this MOU, both the Parties will be relieved of their obligations save such liabilities that accrue prior to the termination or expiry of this MOU.
- 4) Representations and Warranties: Each of the Parties represents and warrants that it has the capacity to enter into this MOU and perform this MOU and all activities contemplated herein.
- 5) Confidentiality: Any information exchanged between the Parties, which is of proprietary and confidential nature, whether or not marked as such, will be treated as Confidential Information. The Parties will protect and maintain the secrecy of Confidential Information exchanged between them and shall disclose the Confidential Information only to its authorized personnel on a need to know basis. Either Party will send a reasonable prior written intimation to the other Party in the event either Party intends to make any public release / statement with regard to this MOU and / or matters contemplated herein.
- 6) Intellectual Property Rights: Each Party is the sole and exclusive owner of its Intellectual Property Rights and will not dispute the ownership in Intellectual Property Rights of the other Party. The Parties will seek each other's prior written approval in the event one Party seeks access to the intellectual property of the other Party. The approval to such access, if granted, will be solely for the purposes of this MOU and will not be construed as any transfer of ownership or grant of license.

The total aggregate liability of one Party towards the other Party will not in any event exceed the sums actually incurred by the Party so liable in performing its respective obligations hereunder.
