Sr. No.	Action Taken
1	The syllabus and curriculum for the First year of UG under Autonomy was approved in the newly formed BoSs and Academic Council. It is being implemented from June 2018.
2	The new Autonomous curriculum was introduced in the Choice Based Credit System framework as per the guidelines of UGC and Shivaji University, Kolhapur.
3	A special committee prepared the Academic Calender in the beginning of the year. Academic activities were carried out as per the Academic Calender.
4	B.Voc.(Animation and Film Making) was approved newly and is being run successfully from June 2018.
5	Value education curriculum was developed and implemented. One lecture every week is allotted in the time table for value education classes.
6	1. A Workshop on "E-content Development and MOODLE" was organised in the month of August in collaboration with Knowledge Bridge Foundation, Ahmadnagar. 2. Two days Workshop on "E-content Development for Pedagogical Skills"
7	'Vivekanand Innovation and Incubation Centre' was established. Its policy and procedure were framed as a part of Research Policy.
8	Proposals of research projects were invited from teachers. after scrutiny by the Research Committee, the selected projects were granted with institutional seed money.
9	A Workshop on 'Intellectual Property Rights and Drafting Patents' was organised by IQAC on 19/02/2019.
10	As a result of the activities and incentives provided to teachers to motivate research output, 20 books/book chapters and 32 research papers were published in UGC enlisted international and national research journals, 76 teachers presented their papers in conferences.
11	18 new MoUs were signed with the industry.
12	Teachers exchange programmes with Kamala College, Kolhapur and Bhaurao Kakatkar College, Belgaon were conducted.
13	To impart transferable and life skills, 11 value added were conducted successfully with 363 beneficiaries.
14	1. English speaking training sessions were conducted for the non-teaching staff in the month of August. 2. Master cloud software training programme for administrative office staff.



15	<p>A structured feedback was collected from all the stakeholders and it was analysed for valuable inputs and decisions were taken as: 1. students will do two value-added courses as per their choice from the given list in their graduation period.</p> <p>3. a competitive examination centre and a personality development centre have been started in the college.</p> <p>4. Students' and alumni's feedback on curriculum was used in the selection of Value Added Courses to offer to students from amongst the many proposals by departments.</p>

17	<p>1. Students of all the graduation programmes were allotted to teacher mentors in November 2018.</p> <p>2. The objectives of mentoring were conveyed to the mentors.</p> <p>3. The mentors were given the registers to maintain the record of issues addressed.</p> <p>4. Students were given counselling on their academic, financial and psychological problems by the mentors</p>
18	<p>The newly formed Examination Cell under Autonomy was provided with all infrastructure in order to conduct the first year UG exams successfully within the stipulated time period.</p>
19	<p>Apart from the NCC and NSS activities, various social outreach programmes organised by all departments.</p> <p>e.g. department of English students were encouraged to conduct classes in their nearby schools.</p>
20	<p>Cloth bags prepared by Home Science department and widely distributed to create awareness</p>
21	<p>1. Health Awareness campaign under Sachetana Mandal organised on 10/08/2018</p> <p>2. Eye check- up camp on 10/10/2018</p>
22	<p>Personality development course was run by B.C.S.</p>
23	<p>Industries like L T Constructions, LG, Infosys, Cholamandalam, Wipro were invited for campus drive.</p>
24	<p>'Vivekanand Mahotsav:Shodh Chaitanyacha' a mega event for students was organised to explore, Promote support the hidden skills and talent in the students. The event constitutes various competitions such as debate, Abhi vachan, Short film making, Innovative research etc.</p>
