**Item no.1 : Confirmation of the minutes of the previous meeting.**



Minutes of the last meeting of the Academic council held on 15.07.2022 were read out by the member secretary Dr. Shruti Joshi along with the action taken report. The minutes were confirmed.

1.	<b>Confirmation of the minutes of the previous meeting.</b>	The previous meeting of Academic Council was held on 18 <sup>th</sup> April 2022. The minutes were read and confirmed.
2.	<b>To finalize the syllabi of all courses (UG Part II) to be implemented from the academic year 2022-23.</b>	The proposed syllabi of all UG Part II courses were finalized after corrections. It was implemented from the academic year 2022-23.
3.	<b>To present the analysis of feedback on curriculum taken from all stakeholders. (SSS)(feedback report)</b>	As per Dr. Bachulkar's suggestion, teachers' feedback on increasing practical component is incorporated in the new structure 35:15.
4.	<b>To update and finalize the research policy.</b>	As per Dr. Bachulkar's suggestion, the temporary teachers were motivated to apply for MRPs. Accordingly, during 2022-23, 13 temporary teachers (5 permanent) applied. After scrutiny, they were granted seed money (min. 30000/-) which will be disbursed in this semester.
5.	<b>To report the conduction of second term examinations.</b>	To orient the teaching, non-teaching staff regarding their pre, during and post-exam duties, a workshop on "Sanctity and confidentiality of Examination" was organized on 5.12.2022. This helped in smooth conduction of first term exams. As per the new UGC guideline, Research committee is reframed and is renamed as Research Advisory Council (RAC).
6.	<b>Any other matter with the permission of the chair. 1. To discuss the possibility of merging the BoS of Botany and Plant Protection.</b>	The BoS for Botany and Plant Protection were merged and have started functioning as one from the academic year 2022-23.





**Item no.2 : To discuss the draft syllabi of all Part III courses to be implemented from the academic year 2023- 24.**

The deans of all faculties – Dr. S.R. Kattimani (Arts and Humanities), Mr. S.S. Kale (Commerce and Management), Dr. M.M. Karanjkar (Science), Mrs. R. Y. Patil (Professional Courses)- presented the draft syllabi of UG Part III, PG Part II and other value added courses which will be implemented from the year 2023-24. The syllabi were approved by the members of Academic Council after corrections.

**Item no. 3: To discuss the COs of proposed syllabi with reference to the cross-cutting issues, employability and skill-development related content.**

While presenting the draft syllabi, the deans also discussed the percentage of change, inclusion of cross cutting issues, relatedness to local, global, national needs and employability components of the proposed syllabi. The related COs were presented accordingly.

**Item no.4 : To discuss about incorporation of MOOCs at UG(TY) and PG(SY) level.**

As per the recommendations of NEP-2020, online component in the curriculum is increased. The college has developed an infrastructure for lecture capturing . Departments are instructed to prepare at least one MOOC in four quadrant structure. Our own LMS platform is prepared on which these MOOCs will be launched. Also, where possible SWAYAM and other such online courses will be incorporated in the syllabi at UG (TY) and PG(SY) level. The discussions were carried out regarding this.

**Item no. 5: To approve the minutes of IQAC**

The meeting of IQAC was held on 10.1.23. The proceedings of this meeting were read out by IQAC coordinator and they were confirmed by the members.

**Item no. 6: To discuss about 4 year degree course to be started from the academic year 2023-24 according to NEP-2020**



Dr. M. M. Karanjkar presented the CBCS structure of 4 year degree programme based on the guidelines of NEP -2020 and UGC. It was resolved that with correction, the structure will be accepted.

After discussion, it was agreed upon that the deans and BoS chairmen will conduct a meeting to finalize the credit system, multidisciplinary courses structure etc. and then the final decision will taken by Governing Body of the college.

**Item no. 7: To consider the possibility of appointments of Adjunct professors / research professor.**

Prin. Dr R. R. Kumbhar discussed the need of research oriented experienced teachers at PG level. In order to incorporate such faculty, he implored the members to consider the possibility of appointing Adjunct professor / research professor. The members unanimously agreed to him.

**Item no.8: To inform about proposals for new programmes –M.Sc. (Applied Statistics), M.Sc. (Biotechnology)**

Prin. Dr R. R. Kumbhar informed the council members about the proposals sent to the University for starting new programmes in M.Sc. (Applied Statistics) and M.Sc. (Biotechnology).

**Item no. 9: To inform about additional divisions of BCA Part I (3<sup>rd</sup> Division), B.Sc. Part I Comp. Sci. Entire (2<sup>nd</sup> Division), B.SC. Part I (Microbiology, Biotech, Comp. Sci.)**

In the view of the increasing demand of students, it is necessary to increase the number of divisions of certain courses in the academic year 2023-24. Therefore, application for the approval of additional divisions of BCA Part I (3<sup>rd</sup> Division), B.Sc. Part I Comp. Sci. Entire (2<sup>nd</sup> Division), B.Sc. Part I (Microbiology, Biotech., Comp. Sci.) was sent to SUK. This was informed by Prin. Dr R. R. Kumbhar to the Council.

**Item no. 10: To present and discuss the analysis of Feedback on curriculum.**

The analysis of feedback on curriculum taken from all stakeholders during the academic year 2021-22 was presented by Ms. Samiksha Farakate.

**Item No. 2: To discuss the course structure of all Part I courses to be implemented from the Academic Year 2021-22.**

The Dean of Arts and Commerce Faculty Dr. S. R. Kattimani and the Dean of Sciences Dr. M. M. Karanjkar presented before the committee the CBCS course structure and the alterations therein to be implemented from the Academic Year 2021-22.



Dr. S. R. Kattimani proposed the new pattern of internal assessment for BA programme. It was proposed that the 10 marks in the 40:10 division of CIE and Semester end examination will be converted from 30 marks' internal examination; the CIE for BA programme will consist of two tests (10 marks each) and a skill oriented activity (Semester I: Summary writing /note-making, Semester II : Book review / film review) (10 marks).

Dr. M. M. Karanjkar presented the conversion of one 80 mark paper into two 40 marks' papers of each course in the B.Sc. programme.

The Chairpersons of respective Boards of Study presented the draft syllabi of their Part I courses. The external members in the Council gave suggestions for the same.

It was resolved that the changes proposed in the CIE of BA programme and the course structure of B.Sc. programme are sanctioned and will be introduced from the academic year 2021-22.

**Item No. 3: To sanction the implementation of M.Voc. Courses.**

The Chairperson of B.Voc.(Graphic Design) Mr. Satish Uplawikar and Mr. Abhijit Mane of Foundary Technology presented the syllabi of M.Voc. Part I courses.

The committee sanctioned the implementation of M.Voc. Courses from the current academic year.

**Item No. 4: To finalise research and consultancy policy.**

Dr. Shubahngi Kale, the Chairman of Criterion III presented the research and consultancy policy prepared by the Research Committee of the college.

Dr. Delekar suggested that the college should provide funds to the faculty members for filing patents and it should be mentioned in the Research Policy. Dr. S. H. Thakar suggested that after production of the Patented research, certain percentage of the profit should be shared with the institution by the faculty member. This has to be mentioned in the policy as well. The suggestions were accepted by the Council.

After discussion, the proposed policy was unanimously sanctioned.

**Item No. 5: To discuss about starting selected value added courses.**

Dr. M. M. Karanjkar, Dean, Science Faculty presented the list of value added courses proposed to be introduced in the year 2021-22. He explained the rationale behind choosing the said courses.

The proposed list was finalized for introduction from the year 2021-22.

**Item No. 6: To discuss about the proposal of enlisting Vivek research journal in UGC list.**





Dr. M. M. Karanjkar proposed on behalf of the Research Committee that Vivek research journal be sought to be included in the UGC list so as to fetch good research contributions from the research fraternity to the journal in the future.

The proposal was unanimously sanctioned.

**Item No. 7: Any other matter with the permission of the Chair.**

Dr. S.S. Mahajan, Representative of the University, took a review of the academic journey of the college during the three years of Autonomous Status and enlisted the challenges ahead. He extended wishes to the college for its future academic progress.

As there was no other matter to be discussed, the meeting ended with thanks to the Chair proposed by Dr. M. M. Karanjkar.

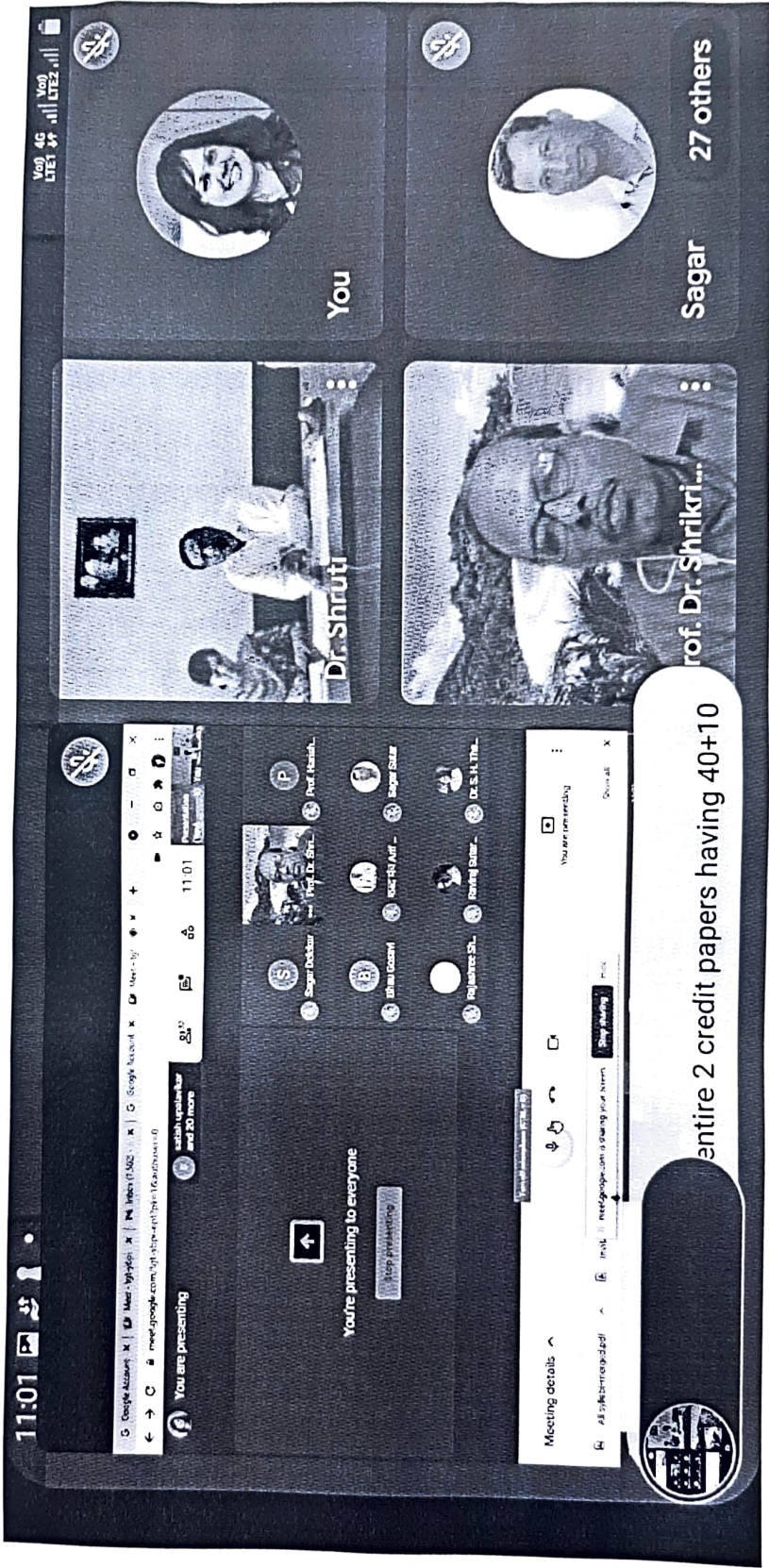

**Item No.2 : To finalize the syllabi and course structure of all Part I courses to be implemented from the academic year 2021-22.**

The syllabi and course structure of all Part I courses to be implemented from the academic year 2021-22 was already analysed by the members. It was suggested that the structure for all the three years of graduate programmes should be formed together and not that of Part I only. After discussion with and suggestions from the respected members, it was decided that the 80:20 marking pattern approved in the previous meeting will be changed to 70:30 . The 70:30 pattern will be introduced from the first year of the degree programme itself i.e. from the academic year 2021-22.



The practical component in evaluation will be increased. It will be assessed within the internal evaluation of 30 marks. The active participation of students in classroom activities will be also considered under it.

The deans were requested to change the previous course structure and present it to the teachers.

The syllabi of all Part I courses was finalised after adding the new course structure (70:30) and evaluation pattern . Dr. Mahajan suggested that PSOs should be also mentioned along with the POs and Cos, as well as the credit system should be clarified in the syllabi.

The syllabi and course structure were approved with amendments.

**Item No. 3 : To report about conduction of courses other than the selected value added courses during this semester.**

The previously sanctioned value added courses for the year 2020-21 were not conducted due the online mode accepted during the Covid pandemic. Instead new courses were conducted according to the feasibility. These courses were : **Certificate Course in German Language, Certificate Course in Human Rights, Bioinstrumentation, Gardening and Landscape Design.** These courses were approved by the Academic council members after a brief discussion about their learning outcomes.

**Item no. 4 : To approve the POs being introduced from 2021-22.**

The POs of all faculties were already studied by the members. Dr. Delekar suggested that the number of POs from all faculties should be same (maximum 6 POs). It will be easier while mapping them with the Cos.

The suggestions were accepted and approved with corrections.

**Item no. 5 : To discuss about proposals for introducing new programmes under B.Voc. and B.Com.**

After a short discussion, the members approved the possibility of starting new courses under B.Voc. (Beauty Parlour, Hotel Management, Agriculture) and B.Com. programme (Information Technology –Entire). Dr. Delekar suggested to consider the possibility of starting programmes like B.Voc. in Artificial Intelligence, Machine Learning, Data Analysis as per the need of time.



**Item no.6 : To discuss the possibility of establishing a foreign language centre.**

The possibility of starting different certificate and diploma courses in foreign languages under a Foreign Languages studies centre / Centre for Foreign Languages was discussed. It was approved by the respected members.

It was suggested that levels of the courses should be decided first based on the structure of IGNOU. Further, it was suggested that the Governments of Germany or Japan can be applied to for funding or cultural projects.

1. To discuss the proposal of separate BoS for B.Com. (Business Economics) and BBA .

In the last meeting, some corrections were suggested which were incorporated this time in the presentations of the Deans.

The syllabi were approved by the members of Academic Council after corrections.

**Item no. 3 To present the analysis of feedback on curriculum taken from all stakeholders.**

The analysis of feedback on curriculum taken from all stakeholders was presented by Ms. Samiksha Farakate.

Dr. Bachulkar suggested that the teachers' suggestions upon upgrading syllabi must be taken into consideration. As it was obvious from the feedback, most teachers suggested to have the practical component increased in the syllabi. Prin. Dr. R. R. Kumbhar remarked that it is the teachers' duty to get the practical component sanctioned from the respective BoS.

**Item no.4 To update and finalize the research policy.**

In the previous meeting, it was suggested to separately mention X-Plagiarism and Research Ethics in the Research policy of the college. The changes were made accordingly. Dr. Shubhangi Kale presented the changes and also, informed about the teachers' MRPs under scrutiny by the university experts.



Dr. Bachulkar suggested that the research expertise of temporary teachers can also be utilized by the college through minor research projects (1/2 yrs). These teachers should be stimulated for improving research output of the college.

**Item no.5 To report the conduction of second term examinations.**

Prin. Dr. R.R. Kumbhar reported that the college took the decision of conducting offline Descriptive Examinations instead of online/offline MCQ pattern exams as conducted by the University. Through well checked out pre, during and post- exam procedures the exams are being conducted successfully and even the results of some third year programmes are declared within 28 days. The exam software is being updated continuously as per the requirements to avoid errors and delays in exam process.

**Item no.6 Any other matter with the permission of the chair.**

**1. To discuss the possibility of merging the BoS of Botany and Plant Protection.**

The course in Plant Protection is prescribed only at SY level to B.Sc. The separate BoS is in function for that. However, it was resolved that the BoS for Botany and Plant Protection will be merged and function as one from the academic year 2022-23.





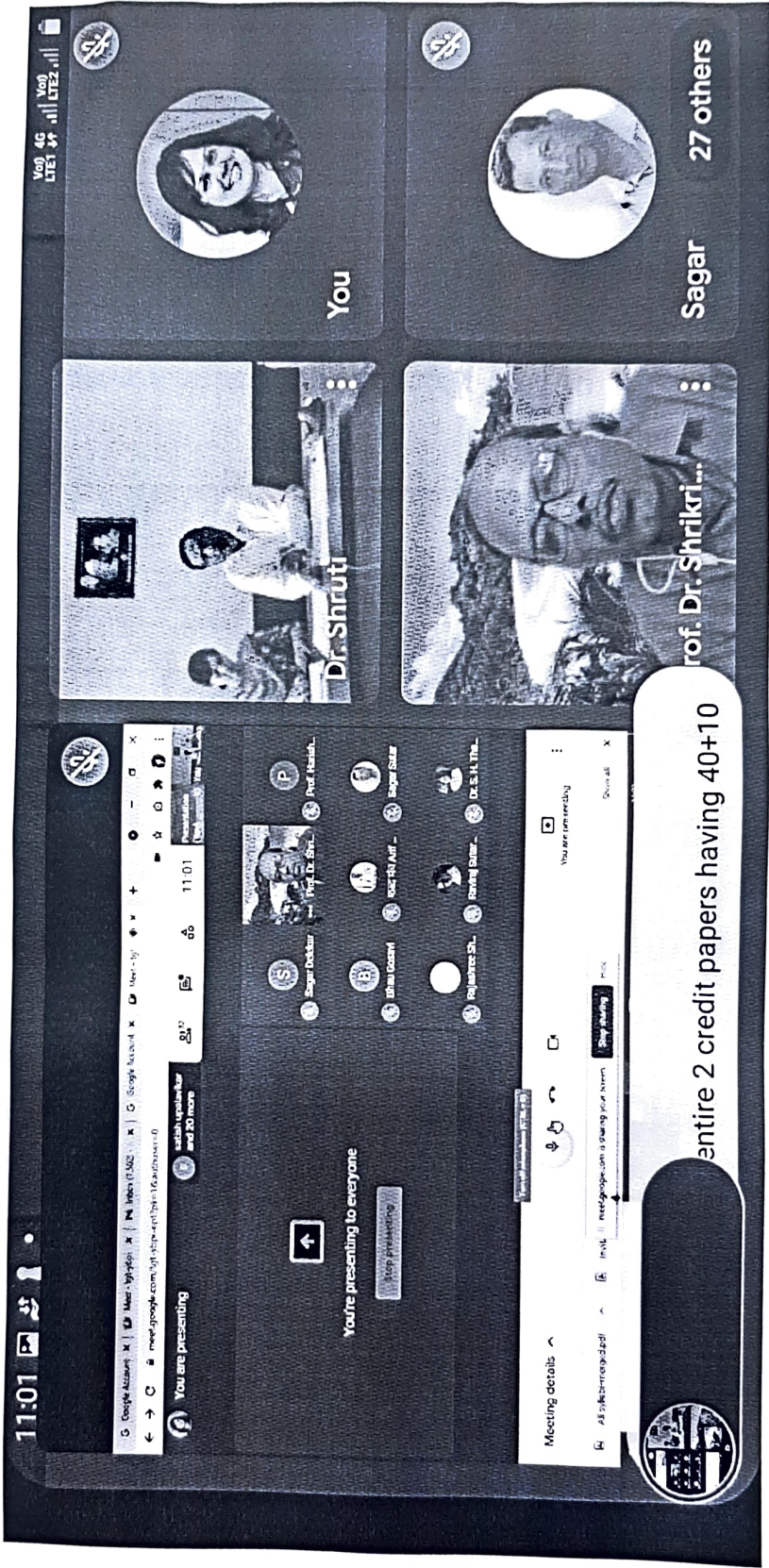

**Item No.2 : To finalize the syllabi and course structure of all Part I courses to be implemented from the academic year 2021-22.**

The syllabi and course structure of all Part I courses to be implemented from the academic year 2021-22 was already analysed by the members. It was suggested that the structure for all the three years of graduate programmes should be formed together and not that of Part I only. After discussion with and suggestions from the respected members, it was decided that the 80:20 marking pattern approved in the previous meeting will be changed to 70:30 . The 70:30 pattern will be introduced from the first year of the degree programme itself i.e. from the academic year 2021-22.



The practical component in evaluation will be increased. It will be assessed within the internal evaluation of 30 marks. The active participation of students in classroom activities will be also considered under it.

The deans were requested to change the previous course structure and present it to the teachers.

The syllabi of all Part I courses was finalised after adding the new course structure (70:30) and evaluation pattern . Dr. Mahajan suggested that PSOs should be also mentioned along with the POs and Cos, as well as the credit system should be clarified in the syllabi.

The syllabi and course structure were approved with amendments.

**Item No. 3 : To report about conduction of courses other than the selected value added courses during this semester.**

The previously sanctioned value added courses for the year 2020-21 were not conducted due the online mode accepted during the Covid pandemic. Instead new courses were conducted according to the feasibility. These courses were : **Certificate Course in German Language, Certificate Course in Human Rights, Bioinstrumentation, Gardening and Landscape Design.** These courses were approved by the Academic council members after a brief discussion about their learning outcomes.

**Item no. 4 : To approve the POs being introduced from 2021-22.**

The POs of all faculties were already studied by the members. Dr. Delekar suggested that the number of POs from all faculties should be same (maximum 6 POs). It will be easier while mapping them with the Cos.

The suggestions were accepted and approved with corrections.

**Item no. 5 : To discuss about proposals for introducing new programmes under B.Voc. and B.Com.**

After a short discussion, the members approved the possibility of starting new courses under B.Voc. (Beauty Parlour, Hotel Management, Agriculture) and B.Com. programme (Information Technology –Entire). Dr. Delekar suggested to consider the possibility of starting programmes like B.Voc. in Artificial Intelligence, Machine Learning, Data Analysis as per the need of time.





**Item no.6 : To discuss the possibility of establishing a foreign language centre.**

The possibility of starting different certificate and diploma courses in foreign languages under a Foreign Languages studies centre / Centre for Foreign Languages was discussed. It was approved by the respected members.

It was suggested that levels of the courses should be decided first based on the structure of IGNOU. Further, it was suggested that the Governments of Germany or Japan can be applied to for funding or cultural projects.

**Item No. 1 : To confirm the minutes of the previous meeting.**

The member secretary Dr. S. M. Joshi read out the minutes of the previous meeting held on 21<sup>st</sup> May 2018 and the minutes were confirmed. The action taken report was also read out by the secretary and it was confirmed.

**Item No. 2 : To scrutinize and approve the proposals of the BoSs with regard to the syllabi of UG courses.**

The chairperson of the meeting asked all 24 BoS chairmen to present the newly framed syllabi of second year of BA, B.Com., B.Sc., BBA, BCA, BCS, B.Sc. Biotechnology through PPT for the perusal of the honourable members of the Academic Council. Accordingly, 24 BoS chairmen presented their syllabi one by one. The honourable members



Of the Academic Council gave their valuable suggestions wherever required and the final approval was given unanimously to the said syllabi.

**Item No. 3 : To approve the syllabi of BoSs with regard to the syllabi for PG Diploma and PG courses.**

The chairman of the committee again asked the concerned BoS chairmen to present the syllabi for the PG diploma and PG courses to be conducted from the Academic Year 2019-20. The BoS chairmen of English, Chemistry, Physics, Mathematics and M.Com. presented their newly formed syllabi for PG diploma and PG courses. The honorable members of the Academic Council gave valuable suggestions wherever required and the final approval was given unanimously.

**Item No. 4 : To define policy for the promotion of research in the college.**

The honourable chairman of the Academic Council informed that the college has taken initiatives like providing seed money for major and minor research projects by the faculty members. He also informed that during this academic year (2018-19), seven teachers have been given Rs. 25000/- each for their research projects. Dr. S. S. Mahajan, University Representative, suggested to establish incubation center of the college. The Principal informed that the process of incubation center has already been started in collaboration with BioEra of Pune. It was unanimously decided that all faculty members should be motivated to undertake research projects. Dr. Madhukar Bachulakar suggested to undertake interdisciplinary research projects. Dr. S.S. Mahajan suggested to have research ethics in the research policy. Dr. A. N. Jagtap suggested to focus on PG level students and to motivate them to write review articles from which potential project ideas can be derived.

**Item No. 5 : To approve the syllabi of add-on and certificate courses.**

The chairmen of the Academic Council asked the BoS chairmen to present their newly formed syllabi for add-on and certificate courses of the department to be implemented from the academic year 2019-20. Accordingly, all BoS chairmen presented their syllabi for add-on and certificate courses through PPT unanimously. The proposed courses are :

Some of the members raised their difficulties and doubts and the concerned difficulties and doubts were cleared by Dr. Karanjkar.

Prin. Dr. S. Y. Hongekar informed that 80-20 pattern of evaluation has been accepted by the college and every BoS has been given the freedom to decide the nature of internal assessment according to their expected learning outcomes.

A. **Compulsion of certificate courses:** Prin. Dr. S. Y. Hongekar suggested to make compulsion of certificate courses to all the students and the required fees to be collected at the time of admission only. Mr. Surendra Jain seconded this suggestion but Dr. Jagtap suggested to take feedback from the outgoing students whether college should make compulsion of certificate courses to all the students and on the basis of feedback by the students, the final decision should be taken in the Governing Body of the college. All the honourable members unanimously agreed to this suggestion.

B. **Interdisciplinary CoC:** Dr. S. S. Mahajan suggested to have interdisciplinary CoCs wherever possible. All the members unanimously agreed to this suggestion.

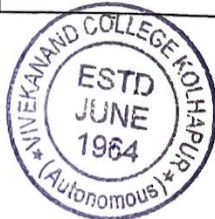

3.	To finalize admission procedure for the first academic year under Autonomy.	The admission committees of respective faculties finalized the rules regarding admission and eligibility and submitted the same by 10 <sup>th</sup> May 2018.
4.	Online admissions of the first year	Mastersoft, Nagpur was contacted and commissioned for providing the online admission software.

**Item No. 2 : To scrutinize and approve the proposals of the BoSs with regards to courses of study.**

The BoS chairmen of all the departments presented the structure of their respective syllabi along with the nature of evaluation and structure of question papers. The marks weightage for theory and internal assessment was decided as 40:10.

It was resolved that for the first year, only 20% changes will be made in the Shivaji University syllabus. 80:20 structure will be accepted for the beginning of the autonomy.

Also, as the time is short to prepare new textbook of English (Compulsory) for the first year, it was unanimously resolved to undertake Shivaji University syllabus for the same for the academic year 2018-19 with minor changes.

**Item No. 3 : To approve the syllabi of add-on and certificate courses.**

All the departments provided the syllabi of add-on and certificated courses related to respective programmes as follows:

It was resolved that every department must conduct at least one add-on course of 1 to 3 months' duration with minimum fees of Rs. 500/- to Rs.1000/-.

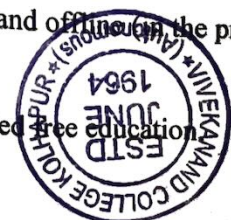
**Item No. 4 : To make regulations regarding the admission of students.**

The combined rules and regulations regarding admission of students to all faculties were read out by Dr. Gawade and were confirmed by the members.

Dr. Jagtap, the expert from outside the college, suggested that the admission committee should consider about prioritized admission policy for the employees of the Sanstha. The Principal informed the Council about online admission procedure.

It was resolved that admission forms will be made available both online and offline (on the prospectus) and the college will provide the facility of online submission.

It was decided that orphan students admitted to the college will be provided free education.





**Item No. 5 : To make regulations for sports and extra-curricular activities.**

Mr . Kiran Patil, the Physical Director, read out the regulations regarding student council and sports. He suggested that 4% reservation for sportsmen should be allowed in the admission process.

Dr. M.S. Ghorpade read out the rules regarding cultural department.

It was resolved that re-exams of the sportsmen and cultural performers who have taken prior permission for absence will be conducted.

**Item No. 6 : To make regulations related to CBCS.**

Dr. M.M. Karanjkar submitted the structure of CBCS.

It was unanimously accepted and confirmed by the members.

**Item No. 7 : To sanction scholarships, studentships, fellowships, prizes and medals and to frame regulations for the award of the same.**

Prin. Dr. S. Y. Hongekar informed about different scholarships, awards and prizes given by the college.

**Item No. 8 : Any other issues with permission of the Chair.**

1. Dr. Kakatkar suggested to identify 25-30 scholar students from B.Sc. Part I and train them exclusively through add-on or certificate courses.
2. Further, Dr. Kakatkar suggested to organize advanced teachers' training programmes .
3. Dr. Bachulkar suggested that the syllabi under autonomy should be different from other institutes, and teachers must prepare their own textbooks and notes.
4. Mr. Surendra Jain underlined the importance of time-related changes to be made in the syllabus and curriculum.

As there was no other issue to discuss, the meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the Chair.
