7.	Brief Discussion	<p>India, the largest democracy in the world, witnessed over 200 years of struggle by its citizens against colonial rule. They made sacrifices to free the nation from the harsh abuse of the British Empire. However, at the time of India's independence, British rulers created unfair political divisions, splitting the vast landmass into three parts based on caste and religion. East and West Pakistan emerged as Islamic nations.</p> <p>Despite the migration of a significant number of refugees from East and West Pakistan to India, and vice versa, the process was marked by physical, mental, and emotional struggles. The Indian government has chosen to commemorate and reflect on the horrors of partition. Prof. S. A. Kattimani, the Head of the History Department, delivered a lecture on the subject. The program was guided by Principal R. R. Kumbhar, Captain Sunita Bhosale, and Lieutenant J. R. Bharamgonda with 90 cadets in attendance. The outcomes of the program include the cadets' analysis of the adverse impacts of caste and</p>								

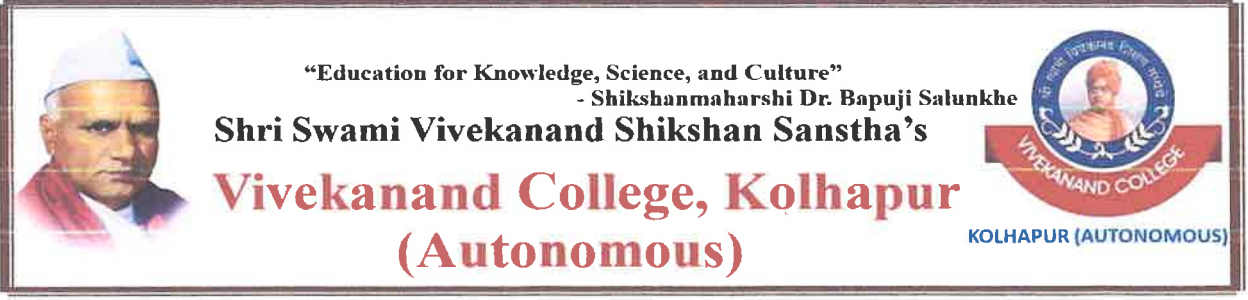
		religious discrimination. They have pledged to live in social harmony, fostering a sense of humanity beyond castism and regionalism.

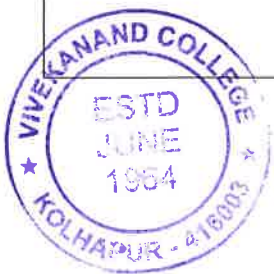
