The proceedings of the meeting are as follows:

Item no.1: To welcome the newly appointed members of the council

As the tenure of earlier members (Experts from outside the college and University Nominees) of the council was over, new members are nominated from the academic year 2021-22 till 2023-24. As Experts from outside the college, Dr. A. A. Karande (Former Secretary, Shri Swami Vivekanand Shikshan Sanstha, Kolhapur), Ms. Divya Menon (MD, Menon and Menon, Kolhapur), Dr. Asha Shitole (Gynecologist, Kolhapur) were welcomed. As University Nominees, Dr. P.V. Anbhule (Dept. of Chemistry), Dr. M.S. Deshmukh (Dept. of Economics) and Dr. Prakash Pawar (Dept. of Political Science) were welcomed by the Council members.

Item no. 2: Confirmation of minutes of the previous meeting

After welcoming the newly appointed council members and introducing them to the college through a short clip on the college, the meeting started formally. Minutes of the last meeting of the Academic council held on 17th June 2021 were read out by the member secretary Dr. Shruti Joshi along with the action taken report. The minutes were confirmed.

Action Taken Report of the Meeting of Academic Council held on 17th June 2021

1.	Confirmation of minutes of the previous Meeting.	The minutes of the previous meeting held on 4 th February 2021 were read and confirmed. The action taken report was presented.
2.	To finalize the syllabi and course structure of all Part I courses to be implemented from the academic year 2021-22.	The Part I syllabi was implemented in the academic year 2021-22. 70:30 pattern of evaluation was also accepted and implemented.
3.	To report about conduction of courses other than the selected value added courses during this semester.	Reported.



4.	To approve the POs being introduced from 2021-22.	As per suggestion of the members, POs were uniformly formed.
5.	To discuss about proposals for introducing new programmes under B.Voc. and B.Com.	Since the UGC portal for B.Voc. courses was not open, no proposals were sent. The proposal for starting B.Com. courses is under consideration.
6.	To discuss the possibility of establishing a foreign language centre.	The Foreign Language Studies Centre was established. Basic German Language course (2 batches) and Basic French language course (1 batch) have been conducted successfully through online and offline mode. IELTS course is being conducted currently.
7.	Any other matter with the permission of the Chair. 1. To discuss the proposal of separate BoS for B.Com. (Business Economics) and BBA.	The separate BoS for B.Com. (Business Economics) and BBA have been established.

Item no.3 : To discuss the draft syllabi of all Part II courses to be implemented from the academic year 2022-23.

The deans of all faculties - Dr. S.R. Kattimani (Arts and Humanities), Mr. S.S. Kale (Commerce and Management), Dr. M.M. Karanjkar (Science), Mrs. R. Y. Patil (Professional Courses)- presented the proposed syllabi of Part II courses which will be implemented from the year 2022-23. However, only titles and the percentage of proposed change were presented along with the evaluation pattern. The contents are still being worked upon.

The members of Council also discussed and approved the POs which were framed earlier. Dr. A. A. Karande stressed that practical component in the syllabi must be increased for successful attainment of POs. Dr. M.S. Deshmukh suggested that the number of POs should be limited to 5-6 across all the faculties so as to facilitate the CO-PO mapping.

Item no.4: To discuss the COs of proposed syllabi with reference to the cross-cutting issues, employability and skill-development related content.



While presenting the proposed syllabi, the deans also presented the COs of new courses with reference to the cross-cutting issues, employability and skill-development related content.

Ms. Divya Menon advised to incorporate Geo-Politics considering its implications in government policies and recent global situations. She suggested offering courses according to the needs and learning objectives of the students. Dr. P.V. Anbhule suggested that every faculty, and not only Commerce, should introduce courses with entrepreneurship component and institutionalized innovative activities should be focused.

Item no.5 : To discuss about incorporation of MOOCs at UG (TY) and PG (SY) level.

Considering the importance given by NEP-2020 to incorporation of online learning mode into the teaching-learning process, the members discussed the possibilities of incorporation of MOOCs in syllabi. It was resolved that MOOCs (available on SWAYAM platform or specially designed by the faculty members) will be incorporated at UG (TY) and PG (SY) level from the year 2022-23.

Item no.6 : To prepare a strategy for the implementation of new programmes M.Sc. (Analytical Chemistry, Statistics, Computer Science, Microbiology), MA(History), PG diploma(Geo-Informatics)

The chairman Prin. Dr. R.R. Kumbhar informed the members that proposals were sent to the university for starting new programmes in M.Sc. (Analytical Chemistry, Statistics, Computer Science, Microbiology), M.A. (History), PG diploma(Geo-Informatics). A discussion was carried out regarding the needed infrastructure.

Dr. P.V. Anbhule cautioned that to compete with other PG centres, it will be important to maintain the quality of syllabi of the proposed PG courses. Also, the institution must invest in lab space and instruments to get good returns. 50 : 50 structure (theory : practical) must be accepted for skills-based programmes. Dr. Asha Shitole informed that Microbiology subject is prescribed for first year MBBS. Students with M.Sc. (Microbiology) degree can have job opportunities there. Dr. M.P. Bachulkar pointed out at the possibility of developing a lab for Agricultural microbiology.



Item no. 7 : To inform about approval to additional division of B.Com. I and M.Sc. (Physics)

The chairman Prin. Dr. R.R. Kumbhar informed the members that the college has received an approval for additional division of B.Com.I and M.Sc. (Physics) as per the increasing demand from the stakeholders.

Item no. 8 : To ask permission for application to start B.A.(Journalism) and PGDT.

The possibility of starting B.A.(Journalism) and PGDT was discussed and permission was asked for the application of the same. However, after discussion it was decided that application for only Post-graduate Diploma in Translation will be sent. B.A. (Journalism) may be considered only if we can offer innovative and qualitative content.

Item no. 9 : To discuss and invite suggestions regarding starting interdisciplinary courses from the academic year 2022-23.

NEP-2020 has focused on offering interdisciplinary courses. So, suggestions regarding starting interdisciplinary courses from the academic year 2022-23 were invited. The feasibility of time-table was suggested. It was agreed upon that apart from introducing new interdisciplinary/multidisciplinary courses, some of the already existing courses can be made open across the faculties.

Item no.10 : Any other matter to discuss:

a) **To present the stakeholders feedback on curriculum and discuss on the action taken so far.**

Ms. Samiksha Farakate presented the feedback taken from all stakeholders on curriculum during 2020-21. The incorporation of their suggestions in the formation of the new syllabus and curriculum was discussed through the action taken so far. The members approved the action taken.

b) **To discuss about Audits (Green Audit, Gender Audit, IT Audit)**

Since it is mandatory to carry out yearly Green Audit, Gender Audit, IT Audit, Prin. Dr. R.R. Kumbhar informed the Council that in the academic year 2021-22, all the audits will be carried out through the Shivaji university.

c) **To discuss the progress in uploading Research repository.**



The member secretary presented the progress in uploading Research repository on the college website. The members of the council motivated the teacher members for a better research output.

d) To finalize the value added courses to be conducted during this academic year

The following value added courses were shortlisted from the proposed list of courses according to the feasibility and availability of resource persons.

e) To finalize Incubation Policy

Dr. Sanjay Ankushrao presented the process of incubation and the incubation policy was finalised with some minor corrections.

f) To discuss about the possibility of starting *Diploma in Travels and Tourism*

Since Kolhapur is a thriving tourist hub, the college has a great opportunity to be a centre of providing skills related to the tourism industry to the students. The members discussed about the possibility of starting *Diploma in Travels and Tourism*. It was decided unanimously that the course will be started from the year 2022-23.

Since there was no other matter to discuss, a vote of thanks was presented by Ms. Samiksha Farakate and the meeting ended with the permission of the Chair.
