Item no. 2 To approve the minutes of IQAC and CDC.

The meeting of IQAC was held on 10.01.2023. The minutes of this meeting were read out by IQAC Coordinator Dr. S. M. Joshi and confirmed by the members.

Dr. B. M. Hirdekar suggested that Army officers should be invited for guidance to the NCC students regarding Republic Day parade.

Dr. H. B. Patil suggested once again to implore the Shivaji University for no discrimination between affiliated and autonomous colleges while distributing university Merit scholarships.

The meeting of College Development Committee was held on 10.01.2023. The minutes of the meeting were read out by Prin. Dr. R. R. Kumbhar and were confirmed by the members.

Item no. 3 To approve the minutes of Academic Council.

The meeting of Academic Council of the college was held on 20.01.2023. Its minutes were read by Prin. Dr. R. R. Kumbhar and were confirmed by the members.

Dr. B.M. Hirdekar suggested that every department must launch their own MOOCS at UG/PG level on the rarest and updated matter/content related to syllabus. Dr. H.B. Patil suggested that we can borrow/introduce the readymade courses launched by the Distance education department of SUK. Dr. Jagannath Patil stressed that NAAC will compulsorily see what the departments have done in this regards. So 40% delivery of syllabus must in online mode and at least one MOOC must be prepared by every subject.



Dr. R. V. Shejwal suggested that the basket of subjects/courses provided under the NEP 2020 structure must be small. Too many options will be taxing for all stakeholders.

Item no.4. To approve the minutes of Finance Committee

The meeting of Finance Committee was held on 25.1.2023. Minutes of the meeting were read by Prin. Dr. R.R. Kumbhar.

Dr. H.B. Patil suggested that the expenses on the development of teaching –learning material and capacity building of teachers should be increased in the future.

Item no.8 : Any other matter with the permission of the Chair.

1. To discuss Institutional Development Plan

All the expert members from outside and management representatives gave certain suggestions: developing language lab, introducing theatrical art course, Establishing an institution like CSIR, a separate institute for leadership development and teachers' training, preparing futuristic classrooms with interactive boards, increase the number of international MoUs.

- It was unanimously accepted that vertical and horizontal development of the college should be focused in the future.


2. Congratulating Dr. Shejwal on his achievement

Dr. R. V. Shejwal has been appointed as a member of Management Council of SUK. He was congratulated by the members of Governing Body.

In the concluding remarks, Dr. Jagannath Patil congratulated the college for our preparation for NEP – 2020. He suggested that there should be brain-storming done by the management related to staff recruitment. The huge gap between remunerations must be bridged.

Since there was no other matter for discussion, Dr. Shruti Joshi expressed a vote of thanks and the meeting ended with the permission of the Chair.
